Petition to Stop the Quail Brush Power Generation Project (QBGP)

Addressed to: California Energy Commission, San Diego City Council, and all agencies

We, the undersigned, petition the California Energy Commission, the San Diego City Council, and all agencies, to categorically reject any proposals by any entity to construct a power plant adjacent to Mission Trails Regional Park (MTRP) – one of the nation's largest natural urban parks and a national treasure.

The proposed QBGP is inconsistent with many of the City of San Diego's laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (LORS). The project conflicts with the East Elliott Community Plan, which appropriately designates the site as *Park, Open Space, and Recreation*, and the Municipal Code, which designates the site's zoning as single-family residential (RS-1-8). The proposed project is located within the City's Multi-Species Conservation Program (MSCP) Subarea Plan, with which it is incompatible. Additionally, the QBGP is sited in the Mission Trails Design District, correctly slated for natural habitat preservation and trail expansion, and is a key wildlife corridor. As a taxpayer, we object to any further spending of California taxpayer dollars in pursuit of a project that violates so many key local land use provisions.

Furthermore, local residents and park users will be negatively impacted by fire danger, air pollution, noise, decreased property values, and visual blight. The QBGP siting threatens the health, recreation, natural beauty, quiet, and quality of life of all San Diego County residents who use MTRP and those who live and work and go to school in the adjacent communities.

We, the undersigned, urge the CEC and all agencies to implement the NO PROJECT ALTERNATIVE.
